

Directions to the Pilgrims' School

To the School from the North

Come off the M3 at Junction 9, where the A34 joins the M3. Do not follow the signs for Winchester, but instead follow signs for Winnall, with Tescos on your left. Continue down the hill until you reach the city one-way system. Turn left and then immediately move to the right hand lane to turn right, signposted to the city centre. This then weaves through the centre until it climbs a brief hill which ends with a t-junction and traffic lights. Turn left and left again at the next set of traffic lights. This is Southgate Street. Continue for half a mile. At the Green Man pub, turn left down St Swithun's Street. Continue straight ahead and through the Cathedral Gate. The school, and limited parking, is on your right.

To the School from the South

Come off the M3 at Junction 11. Follow signs for the city centre and travel through St Cross. Two miles after leaving the motorway, you will reach the Screen Cinema on your left. Turn right opposite this by the Green Man pub, down St Swithun's Street. Continue straight ahead and through the Cathedral Gate. The school, and limited parking, is on your right.

Directions to the Pilgrims' School for matches

We are delighted for parents and friends to attend matches. However, parking is severely limited. If the school car park is full, you are advised to avoid the wrath of the parking attendant and to return to a city car park and walk through. Please do not attempt to park at the front of the school.

To the pitches from the North.

Come off the M3 at Junction 9, where the A34 joins the M3 – the 'Tesco's' roundabout. Follow signs for Winchester along the A33. Join Bar End Road and continue towards the city centre. At the Black Rat restaurant, turn left into Wharf Hill. Follow the road, as it becomes College Walk, to the barrier. On the right is a small car park and the pitches.

To the pitches from the South.

Come off the M3 at Junction 10. Follow signs for Winchester by joining Bar End Road at the first roundabout. Continue towards the city centre. At the Black rat restaurant, turn left into Wharf Hill. Follow the road, as it becomes College Walk, to the barrier. On the right is a small car park and the pitches
