### 7S FRENCH REVISION CHECKLIST

#### The Exams will consist of: FRENCH CASE PAPER

- Three papers + 1 oral exam:
  - *Listening Paper: duration 25 minutes (taken in normal lesson time under exam conditions)*
    - Pupils will listen to a recording in French, answers will be given in English (full sentences will not be required) or by ticking boxes.
  - *Reading Paper: duration 30 minutes*
    - Pupils will read texts of increasing length and detail in French. **The questions and answers are in both French and English.** Full sentences will not be required.
  - *Writing Paper: duration 30 minutes*
    - Long essay (approximately 140 words): an article is to be written based on 5 out of 7 topic areas.
    - It is vital that the **present, imperfect, perfect, future and conditional tenses** are used in the Writing Paper. At least **ONE negative, a comparative, longer sentences and conjunctions** must also be used & a variety of **personal opinions** expressed.
  - *Oral Exam: duration maximum 10 minutes*
    - Based upon the questions from La maison.
    - Pupils should feel confident enough to talk about these subjects 'at ease' rather than feeling they have to learn the answers off by heart.
    - In the exam pupils need to appear to be speaking as naturally as possible.

#### Equipment you will need for the exam:

- Fountain pen and spare cartridges
- Pencil (Eraser/Sharpener)
- Ruler
- Highlighter
