Section 1 Data-Response Questions	This section will comprise two questions.  One question will be based on physical geography and the other on a human geography topic or an environmental topic.	
Section 2 Essay & Structured Questions	This section will consist of six questions.  These will include essay questions as well as more structured questions, containing extended writing.
