

Y7 SPANISH REVISION CHECKLIST

The Exams will consist of:

- Three papers + 1 oral exam:
 - *Listening Paper: duration 30 minutes (taken in normal lesson time under exam conditions)*
 - Pupils will listen to a recording in Spanish but questions are in English, and the answers required will be short and in English to demonstrate comprehension.
 - Full sentences are not required.
 - *Reading Paper: duration 30 minutes*
 - Pupils will read texts of increasing length and detail in Spanish but the questions and (short) answers will be in English.
 - There will be a grammar section where pupils will need to conjugate verbs or similar.
 - *Writing Paper: duration 30 minutes*
 - A letter/email is to be written based on 4 to 6 bullet points on one topic area. (80-120 words)
 - It is to be written in the **present and future** and to include **negatives, opinions, justifications, connectives** and a **variety of vocabulary and sentences**.
 - *Oral Exam: duration maximum 5 minutes (taken in normal lesson time) soon after we come back to school in January.*
 - Questions from any topic area may be asked.
 - Answers must display the ability to understand what is being asked and must be in full sentences.
 - Pupils are expected to be able to extend answers and to speak freely.
 - Pupils are expected to speak fluently but not necessarily rote learn a prepared text – meaningful learning is better.
 - Some pupils will be able to ask questions in return to best simulate a spontaneous, natural conversation.
