

Westbourne House School Spanish Revision - Summer Term



The Exams will consist of:

- Three papers + 1 oral exam:
 - Listening Paper: duration 25 minutes
 - Pupils will listen to a recording in Spanish but the questions and answers will be in English.
 - Full sentences will not be required.
 - o Reading Paper: duration 30 minutes
 - Pupils will read texts of increasing length and detail in Spanish but the questions and answers will be in English.
 - Full sentences will not be required.
 - Writing Paper: duration 30 minutes
 - A letter/ email is to be written based on 4 out of 5 areas. (80-130 words)
 - It is vital that the **preterite**, **present**, **future tenses** are used, in more than just the first person.
 - Oral Exam: duration maximum 5 minutes
 - Based upon a picture that the children talk about on a previous topic, followed by a conversation on the same topic.
 - Pupils should feel confident enough to talk about this subject 'at ease' rather than feeling they have to learn the answers off by heart.
 - Pupils need to appear to be speaking as naturally as possible.
