### Y8 Scholarship MATHS REVISION CHECKLIST

#### **The Exam will consist of:**

Depending on which school you are entered for you will probably be sitting one non-calculator paper. The first half of the paper will test your number and algebra skills and the second half will test your ability to think.

#### **Equipment you will need for the exam:**

- Ruler (15cm and 30cm)
- Pencil
- Eraser and pencil sharpener
- Compass
- Protractor
- For some schools, you will need a calculator

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#### **NOTES/TIPS:**

- You must be really secure on all the level 3 common entrance work. Look at the year 8 revision section and check you are secure on all the topics.
  - Revise by practising the questions you have been given, both CASE and the school that you are going for.
  - Workings are absolutely essential. It should be assumed that any question with more than 1 mark requires at least one line of working. A question worth about 10 marks will require about 10 lines of logical workings. Workings should be clearly presented and not “doodle” like. All workings should be logical.
