 - The CASE Exam is based on the Common Entrance syllabus and is divided into two sections; candidates will be required to **answer one question from each section**.

 - Section 2: Essay & Structured Questions

Section 1 Data-Response Questions	<p>This section will comprise two questions. Answer one question from this section.</p> <p>One question will be based on physical geography and the other on a human geography topic or an environmental topic.</p>	
Section 2 Essay & Structured Questions	<p>This section will consist of six questions. Answer one question from this section.</p> <p>These will include essay questions as well as more structured questions, containing extended writing on:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Volcanoes and Earthquakes • Rivers and Coasts (including flooding) • Weather and Climate • Population and Settlement • Transport and Industry • (Fieldwork) 	
Topics	<p>All revision material specific to this exam will be handed out during the Summer term, with revision sessions built into the Geography timetable.</p> <p>If pupils wish to do any revision before, it is recommended to look at the above topics on the BBC Bitesize website:</p>
